

# **ADD 'EM UP OR NOT BINGO**

Print out as many blank Bingo cards as you need. Grab a deck of cards. Get ready for some action-packed fun!

# Rules

In this game of Add 'em up or Not Bingo, you will use any numbers 1-100 on your card. You may not use numbers more than once. You may fill in one box as your free space.

You will need a deck of cards with the Jokers removed. You will look at the deck sheet for information on the amount each card is worth. Players will use up to 3 cards per round and any combination of addition, subtraction, multiplication, or division to place a token over one of the numbers on their Bingo card. If they only need one card, then that is okay. If they need up to 3 cards, that is okay. If they cannot find a number to place a token on during that round, they will simply miss that turn and wait for their next one. If players run out of cards during play, simply reshuffle the deck and continue. The player to get a Bingo first wins the game. As players cover their numbers, they need to talk outloud and tell the group how they are coming up with their totals. The groups should agree with the player before the player marks their number on their Bingo card.

- **KING=12**
